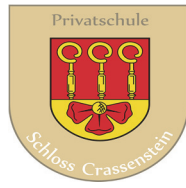


# Privatschule Schloss Crassenstein



## Condition of Acceptance

To be accepted into our IB program, interested students and parents must first complete an assessment form. In this, both the individual student and the respective guardians as our contractual partner should assess how the conditions for this challenging qualification are ordered.

The information, which will of course remain confidential, relates to the child's educational background, personal learning and skill achievements, interests and future aims.

This information should help us give the most precise prognosis possible with regard to the later chances of success en route to achieving the IB Diploma. The applicant's capabilities in English or German and Mathematics constitute a further condition for an as reliable as possible prognosis.

In parallel to this, interested parties will be provided with detailed information on the IB Diploma program during a personal interview. We believe it is important for the parents to also understand and accept the roles of the student and the teacher in this educational approach.

Unlike in the traditional approach, IB teachers assume less the role of the teacher, who imparts material and demands proof of proficiency, and are more like coaches, who rely on their students continuing to work independently.

Students are of course familiarized with all learning techniques, such as "time management". The IB curriculum seeks just this independence however and increasingly expects it as a matter of course.

Before the backdrop of the local school requirements, this is a hurdle that should not be underestimated, but at the same time also represents one of the key opportunities offered by the IB Diploma program with regard to the present-day demand for life-long learning.

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
