

# Scope of application

## Privatschule Schloss Crassenstein GmbH

### **Scope of application**

This data protection declaration is intended to provide users with information on the nature, extent and purpose of the collection and use of personal data by the responsible provider, Privatschule Schloss Crassenstein GmbH, Am Schloss 1, 59329 Wadersloh, on this website (hereinafter referred to as "the offer").

The legal basis for data protection can be found in the Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG) and the Telemediengesetz (TMG).

### **Access data / server log files**

The provider (or his webspace provider) collects data about each access to the offer (so-called server logfiles). Access data includes:

Name of the retrieved web page, file, date and time of the retrieval, transmitted data volume, notification of successful retrieval, browser type and version, the operating system of the user, referrer URL, the IP address and the requesting provider.

The provider uses the log data only for statistical evaluations for the purpose of operation, security and optimization of the offer. However, the provider reserves the right to check the log data at a later date if there is a reasonable suspicion of unlawful use.

### **Contact**

When contacting the provider (for example via a contact form or e-mail), the user's data are stored for the purpose of processing the inquiry as well as in the event that connection questions arise.

### **Integration of third-party services and content**

It is possible that third party contents, such as videos from YouTube, maps from Google Maps, RSS feeds or graphics from other websites, may be included within this website. This always assumes that the providers of these contents (hereinafter referred to as "third-party providers") perceive the IP address of the users. Without the IP address, they could not send the content to the user's browser. The IP address is therefore required for the display of these contents. We only make use of such content, whose respective providers use the IP address only for the delivery of the content. However, if the third-party vendors use the IP address, for example, For statistical purposes. As far as we know, we will clarify the users about it.

## **Use of Facebook Social Plugins**

This offer uses social plugins from the social network facebook.com, operated by Facebook Ireland Ltd., 4 Grand Canal Square, Grand Canal Harbor, Dublin 2, Ireland ("Facebook"). The plugins are recognizable on one of the Facebook logos (white "f" on blue tile, the terms "Like", "Like" or "thumb up") or are marked with the addition "Facebook Social Plugin". When a user browses a web page that contains such a plugin, his browser builds a direct link to the Facebook servers. The content of the plugin is transmitted directly from Facebook to your browser and integrated into it by the website. Therefore, the provider has no influence on the extent of the data that Facebook collects with the help of this plugin and therefore informs the user according to his knowledge:

By integrating the plugins, Facebook receives the information that a user has called the corresponding page of the offer. If the user is logged into Facebook, Facebook can assign the visit to his Facebook account. If users interact with the plugins, for example press the Like button or comment, the corresponding information will be sent directly to Facebook by Facebook and stored there. If a user is not a member of Facebook, there is the possibility that Facebook will find and save his IP address. According to Facebook, only an anonymous IP address is stored in Germany.
